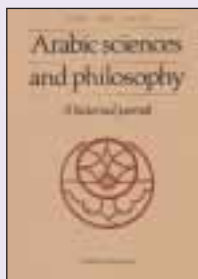
# Arabic Sciences and Philosophy

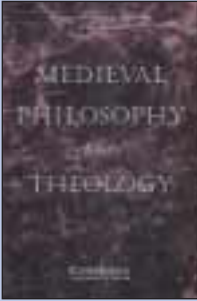
