কই.

ক, The first consonant of the Hindoo alphabet. It has the sound of the English k.

কই, *s.* (from কইয়া, *the name of a species of fish*), a species of fish common in ponds and marshes, (Lutianus scandens. La Cepede. Perca vagabunda. Buchanan's Mss.)

কইয়াত, *a.* (from কই, *the name of a fish*, and যাত, *a fish*), the name of a species of fish, (Perca vagabunda or Lutianus scandens.)

কঙড, *s.* (from কপোত, *a pigeon*), a pigeon.

কএক, *pron.* (from কি, *what*, and এক, *one*), some, a few, several.

কএখা, *s.* (from কনিখ, *the name of a tree*), the name of a tree, (Feronia Elephantium.)

কএদ, *s.* (from कैद, *imprisonment*), imprisonment, confinement.

কএদখানা, *s.* (from कैद, *imprisonment*, and خانه, *a house*), a prison.

কএদী, *a.* (from कैद, *imprisonment*), imprisoned, confined; *s.* a prisoner.

কএরাখানী, *a.* (from کړاښ, *rough*, and খানী, *a mine*), brawling, querulous, contentious, scurrilous. This adjective is only applied to women.

কংস, *s.* (from कंस, *to shine*), white brass or bell-metal. This is a metal composed of seven parts of copper and two of tin. In Hindoo fabulous history, this is the name of a king who was uncle to Krishna, and his mortal enemy.

কংসবিক্ৰ, *s.* (from কংস, *bell-metal*, and বিক্র, *a merchant*), a brazier.

কংসযোফিক্ৰ, *s.* (from কংস, *bell-metal*, and যোফিক্ৰ, *resembling a fly*), a metallic substance in large grains, the size of a pea; probably some sort of Pyrites.

কং, *pron.* (from কি, *what*), who? what?

কইলাবাজুর, *s.* (from কোমল, *tender*, and কংস, *a calf*), a calf under three months of age.

কই.

কই, *s.* (from কই, *to laugh*), immoderate laughter, the noise of immoderate laughter, any cackling noise in the throat.

কইয়া, *v. n.* (from কই, *to laugh*), to cackle, to make a crowing noise in crying.

কইয়াত, *s.* (from কই, *to make a disagreeable noise in crying*), the uttering of a disagreeable crowing sound in immoderate crying, a groaning, a moaning.

কইয়াতী, *s.* (from কই, *to laugh*), a cackling, a disagreeable crowing sound frequently uttered by children when they cry immoderately.

কইয়া, *s.* (from ক, *the letter ক*, and ইয়া, *to make*), the letter ক, or that character which expresses the sound of ক.

কইয়াদি, *a.* (from কইয়া, *the letter ক*, and আদি, *a beginning*), beginning with the letter ক, having an initial ক.

কইয়াত, *a.* (from কইয়া, *the letter ক*, and অন্ত, *an end*), ending with the letter ক, having a final ক.

কইয়া, *s.* (from কইয়া, *the hump on the shoulder of an ox*), the hump or protuberance on the shoulder of an Indian ox or bull.

কইয়া, *s.* (from ক, *happiness*, and ইয়া, *to sound*), the protuberance on the shoulders of the Indian bull, a mark or sign of royalty, a mountain-peak, excellency.

কইয়া, *s.* (from ক, *the wind*, and ইয়া, *to extend*), a point of the compass, space, a quarter or region.

কইয়া, *s.* (from ক, *splendor*, and ইয়া, *to make*), the name of an ornamental tree, (Nauclea parvifolia.)

কইয়া, *s.* (from কই, *to laugh*), an immoderate noise in laughter, a giggling sound often uttered in laughter.

কইয়া, *s.* (from কই, *to be proud*, and ইয়া, *to accumulate*), the name of a fragrant drug said to be the waxy pulp of a certain berry.

কইয়া, *s.* (from কই, *to be proud*, and ইয়া, *to accumulate*), the name of a fragrant drug.

করা.

- করা**, *s.* (from **কর**, *to kill*), the arm-pit, the side, the flank of an animal, the end of the lower garment which is tucked into the waistband.
- করাড**, *a.* (from **কর**, *the side*, and **গড**, *gone*), placed on the side, situated on the side, situated in a particular division or apartment of a court or house.
- করাডুড**, *a.* (from **কর**, *the side*, and **ডুড**, *fallen from*), fallen from the side or hip.
- করাড**, *a.* (from **কর**, *the side*, and **ডা**, *to be situated*), situated on the side or flank, seated on the side or hip, situated in a particular division of a house or court.
- করাডাঙ্গী**, *a.* (from **কর**, *the side*, and **ডাঙ্গী**, *standing*), standing or continuing on the side or flank, standing or continuing in a particular division of a court or house.
- করাডিত**, *a.* (from **কর**, *the side*, and **ডিত**, *situated*), situated on the side or flank, seated on the side or hip, situated in a particular division of a court or house.
- করা**, *s.* (from **কর**, *to kill*), a hawser, a rope to fasten an elephant, a woman's girdle or zone, an enclosure or part of a court yard, an apartment or room of a house, a part of a chariot.
- করাঙ্গা**, *s.* (from **কর**, *to kill*), a hawser, a rope to fasten an elephant, a woman's girdle or belt, an inclosure or subdivision of a court-yard or homestead.
- করা**, *s.* (from **ক** and **অ**, *the two first letters of the alphabet*), the alphabet.
- করা**, *ad.* (from **কি**, *what*, and **কন**, *an instant*), when? at any time.
- করা**, *ad.* (from **কি**, *what*, **কন**, *an instant*, and **ও**, *also*), now and then, occasionally, sometimes.
- করা**, *s.* (from **ক** and **অ**, *the two first letters of the alphabet*, and **আদি**, *the first*), the Indian alphabet.
- করা**, *s.* (from **কর**, *to move*), a heron; a name of *Yoodisthira*, the name of a particular division of the Continent.
- করা**, *s.* (from **কর**, *agreeably*, and **কন**, *to sound*), a bracelet or ornament for the wrist, a small ornament or bell.
- করা**, *s.* (from **কর**, *to move*), a comb.
- করা**, *s.* (from **করা**, *a heron*, and **করা**, *a bill*), the name of a fish, (*Esox scolopax*, Buchanau's Mss.)
- করা**, *s.* (from **করা**, *gravel*), coarse sand, gravel.
- করা**, *s.* (from **করা**, *a heron*, and **করা**, *to disregard*), the name of a small tree, (*Allangium hexapetalum*), also the name of a cucurbitaceous plant, (*Momordica mixta*.)

- করা**, *s.* (from **করা**, *poor*), poverty, want, penury.
- করা**, *a.* (from **করা**, *poor*), poor, needy.
- করা**, *s.* (from **কর**, *wind*, and **করা**, *to go*), the name of a plant, (*Roscoea pentandra*.)
- করা**, *s.* (from **কর**, *water*, and **করা**, *to go*), the name of a species of small grain, (*Panicum italicum*.)
- করা**, *s.* (from **করা**, *millet*, and **করা**, *to move*), the name of a species of grass, (*Milium filiforme*.)
- করা**, *v. n.* (from **কর**, *to bind*), to be dislocated, to slip out of place.
- করা**, an imitative sound used to express that which arises from cutting any thing in two with a sharp instrument, or from doing any thing at a single blow or effort.
- করা**, *s.* (from **কর**, *to bind*), the hair, in Hindoo story the son of *Vrihupati*, a cicatrix, a dried sore.
- করা**, *s.* (from **করা**, *an imitative sound*), the name of a fish, (*Cyprinus monodactylus*.)
- করা**, *s.* (from **করা**, *a cable*), a cable, a halter, a tethering rope.
- করা**, *s.* (from **করা**, *mountain ebony*), the name of a tree, (*Bauhinia variegata* and *purpurea*.)
- করা**, *s.* an imitative sound to express the chirping noise of the common Mino, (*Turdus canorus*;) it is also used to express a loud supping sound which persons of the lower class often make in eating.
- করা**, *s.* an imitative sound to express the loud chirping of the common Mino, (*Turdus canorus*) also a loud flurrying sound which some persons make in eating.
- করা**, *v. n.* (from **করা**, *to shine*), to shoot forth, to bud.
- করা**, *s.* (from **কর**, *to bind*), a stake or staff, grit or coarse powder, a dislocation.
- করা**, *s.* (from **করা**, *to murmur*), a dispute, a murmuring, a haggling in making a bargain. This word is usually written as above, but ought to be written **করা**, which see.
- করা**, *a* (from **করা**, *to shine*), tender, delicate, young.
- করা**, *s.* (from **করা**, *Arum*), the name of a plant, (*Arum fornicatum*.)
- করা**, *s.* (from **করা**, *to shine*), the generic name of *Arum*, several species of which are cultivated in India as an article of food.
- করা**, *s.* (from **করা**, *Arum*, and **করা**, *a scent*), the name of a plant, (*Calla aromatica*.)
- করা**, *s.* (from **করা**, *happiness*, and **করা**, *to burn*), the name of a sort of cake.

- কচ্‌কচিয়া, *s.* (from কচ্‌কচ্‌, *an imitative sound*), the name of a bird, (*Lanius excubitus*.)
- কচ্‌কচিয়া, *s.* (from কচ্‌কচ্‌ *a rustling*), a sort of coarse grass which is manufactured into mats for the poorer people, (*Cyperus tegetus* and *tegetiformis*.)
- কচ্‌কচী, *s.* (from কচ্‌কচ্‌, *a murmuring*), a murmur, a contention, a tumultuous noise of dissatisfaction.
- কচ্‌কচী, *s.* (from কচ্‌, *unripe*, and কচী, *a young one*), a young child.
- কচ্‌, *s.* (from ক, *water*, and কচ্‌, *to cut*), a shore, a low watery place; the end of the garment worn round the waist which is tucked into the waistband.
- কচ্‌প, *s.* (from কচ্‌, *a shore*, and প, *to drink*), a tortoise, a turtle.
- কচ্‌, *s.* (from কচ্‌, *to injure*), the itch, a scab.
- কচ্‌টে, *v. a.* (from ক, *water*, and টে, *to separate*), to knead, to dab together.
- কচ্‌টোন, *s.* (from ক, *water*, and টন, *to separate*), the kneading of any substance.
- কচ্‌মচ্‌, an imitative sound expressing that which arises from eating unripe or harsh tasted fruits and roots, a crumping sound.
- কচ্‌মচ্‌চি, *s.* (from কচ্‌, *to murmur*, the last syllable is only used to rhyme with the first), a dispute, a quarrel, a brawl, a murmuring.
- কচ্‌মান, *s.* (from কচ্‌চি, *tender*), the budding of a tree.
- কচ্‌ল, *v. a.* (from ক, *water*, and ল, *to move*), to rub clothes in washing, to rub any thing with water between the hands.
- কচ্‌লন, *s.* (from ক, *water*, and লন, *to move*), the rubbing of cloth in washing, the rinsing of any thing.
- কচ্‌লা, *v. a.* (from ক, *water*, and ল, *to move*), to rub clothes in washing, to rub any thing with water between the hands.
- কচ্‌লান, *s.* (from কচ্‌লা, *to rub in washing*), the rubbing of clothes in washing, the rubbing of any thing wet between the hands.
- কচ্‌লানি, *s.* (from কচ্‌লা, *to rub in washing*), the rubbing of clothes in washing, the rubbing of any thing wet between the hands.
- কচ্‌শী, *s.* (from কচ্‌, *to shine*), the generic name of Arum.
- কচ্‌হরী, *s.* (from কচ্‌, *a shore*, and হ, *to take*), a court of law, an office where any public business is transacted.
- কচ্‌হরী, *s.* (from কচ্‌হরী, *a court house*), a court of law, an office where public business is transacted.
- কচ্‌জিয়া, *s.* (from كَجِيْم, *a dispute*), a quarrel, a dispute.

কটে.

- কচ্‌কল, *s.* (from কচ্‌, *bad*, and কল, *water*), a black substance used by the Hindoos to paint the eye-lids; this was formerly thought to be antimony, but is now ascertained to be a sort of lead ore.
- কচ্‌কলা, *s.* (from কচ্‌, *bad*, and কল, *water*, the name of a fresh water fish, (*Cyprinus atratus*.)
- কচ্‌কলী, *s.* (from কচ্‌কল, *a black ore of lead*), Ethiops mineral.
- কচ্‌কুল, *s.* (from কচ্‌, *bad*, and কুল, *a blaze*), lamp black, especially when considered as an application to the eyes.
- কচ্‌কী, *s.* (from কচ্‌, *to bind*), a branch or twig of bamboo.
- কচ্‌কু, *s.* (from কচ্‌, *to bind*), the skin of a snake, the slough or skin of a serpent when cast off.
- কচ্‌কুক, *s.* (from কচ্‌, *to bind*), the skin of a snake, armour, mail, a bodice or jacket, a garment, a pair of short drawers.
- কচ্‌কুকাল, *s.* (from কচ্‌কু, *the skin of a snake*, and কাল, *black*), the black variety of the cobra de capello, (*Coluber najas*.)
- কচ্‌কুলিক, *s.* (from কচ্‌কু, *the skin of a serpent*), a woman's bodice or jacket.
- কচ্‌কুল, *s.* (from কচ্‌, *to grow*), Brubma, the sun, the belly, a ropemaker.
- কচ্‌কুলতা, *s.* (from কচ্‌, *water*, কুল, *to be produced*, and লতা, *a climbing plant*), the name of a plant, (*Asclepias odoratissima*.)
- কচ্‌টে, *v. n.* (from কচ্‌টে, *to have a colour*), to fade, to become flaccid, to wither, to become yellow as a decaying leaf.
- কচ্‌টে, *s.* (from কচ্‌টে, *to surround*), the hip, the hollow above the hip or the loins, also the hip and loins. The temples of an elephant, a mat, a skreen or fence of grass, a fixed period, a treaty, a bond.
- কচ্‌টে, *ad.* (from কচ্‌টে, *to move*), suddenly, unexpectedly, hastily.
- কচ্‌টেক, *s.* (from কচ্‌টে, *to encompass*), a camp, a circle, a ring or bracelet for the wrist, a ring, a handle resembling a ring for drawers, &c. a ring put as an ornament on an elephant's tusk; a city, a royal metropolis, table land on a mountain, the brow of a hill; also in Geography, the name of a part of Ootkula or Oorissa, the name of a city in Oorissa.
- কচ্‌টেলোজা, *s.* (from কচ্‌টে, *harsh tasted*, and হেলোজা, *the liver*), the name of a climbing plant, (*Cæsalpinia Bonduccella*.)
- কচ্‌টেকী, *s.* (from কচ্‌টেকী, *the name of a plant*), the name of a medicinal plant, (*Wrightea antidysenterica*. Brown. Also *Colotropis gigantea*. Brown.)
- কচ্‌টেকীপাড়িয়া, *s.* (from কচ্‌টেক, *Ootkula*, and পাড়ি, *a side piece of a roof*), the name of cloth which has a narrow stripe of red or other colour for a border.

- কড়িবেল, *s.* (from কড়িবেল, *the elephant apple*, and বিন, *the wood-apple*), the elephant apple, (*Feronia Elephantium*).
- কড়িবেল, *s.* an imitative sound used to express a rattling like that made by a person in eating dry and hard substances, or the noise of a rat or mouse when gnawing any thing, a crumping sound.
- কড়িমবেল, *s.* an imitative sound used to express the crumping sound occasioned by eating hard substances, or the noise of a rat or mouse when gnawing a thing.
- কড়িলব, *s.* (from কড়িল, *Artocarpus*, and বটে, *the Indian fig tree*), a species of fig tree, (*Ficus laccifera*).
- কড়িলব, *s.* (from কড়ি, *harsh*, and লব, *salt*), the name of a kind of salt.
- কড়ি, *v. n.* (from কড়ি, *to have a colour*), to fade, to become flaccid, to wither; *a.* withered, faded, flaccid, become yellow as leaves do when withering, sallow, wan; also *pron.* (from কি, *what*, and the syllable ঠে, *how many? how much?*)
- কড়িফ, *s.* (from কড়ি, *to go*, and অক্ষি, *an eye*), a glance, a side glance, an ogling look.
- কড়িফদর্শন, *s.* (from কড়িফ, *a glance*, and দর্শন, *the seeing of any thing*), an indirect glance, an ogling look.
- কড়িচক্ষু, *a.* (from কড়ি, *yellowish*, and চক্ষু, *an eye*), cat-eyed, yellow-eyed.
- কড়ি, *ad.* (from কড়ি, *to move*), unexpectedly, suddenly, hastily.
- কড়ি, *s.* (from কড়ি, *a dagger*), a dagger.
- কড়ি, *s.* (from কড়ি, *to fade*), the circumstance of fading or decaying; *a.* decayed; faded, flaccid, withered.
- কড়ি, *s.* (from কড়ি, *to ruin*, and জল, *enough*), the time of the spring tides, the spring tide.
- কড়ি, *s.* (from কড়ি, *to move*), unexpectedly, suddenly, hastily.
- কড়ি, *s.* (from কড়ি, *much*, and হন, *to smite*), a caldron, a boiler, a frying pan, a pan used for parching corn, a young buffalo whose horns are just appearing, the shell of a tortoise. The name of a particular dweepa or island, the infernal region.
- কড়ি, *s.* (from কড়ি, *to move*), the loins, the hip.
- কড়ি, *s.* (from কড়ি, *to go*), the loins; also the name of a fish, (*Cyprinus trapezoides*, Buchanan's Mss.)
- কড়িভে, *s.* (from কড়ি, *the loins*, and ভে, *a shore*), the loins, the waist.
- কড়িভে, *s.* (from কড়ি, *the loins*, and ভে, *a place*), the loins, the hips, the waist.
- কড়িভে, *s.* (from কড়ি, *the loins*, and ভে, *to place*), the buttocks.

কড়ে.

- কড়িবন্ধনী, *s.* (from কড়ি, *the loins*, and বন্ধনী, *any thing with which another thing is bound*), a girdle for the loins.
- কড়িফ, *a.* (from কড়ি, *hard*), hard, disagreeable, of an inferior quality.
- কড়িফচাউল, *s.* (from কড়িফ, *disagreeable*, and চাউল, *rice*), foul or bad rice.
- কড়িফবীন, *s.* (from কড়িফ, *disagreeable*, and বীন, *unhusked rice*), foul or bad rice.
- কড়িফাংরা, *s.* (from কড়ি, *the side*, and ফাং, *to move*), the name of a fish, (*Cyprinus trapezoides*, Buchanan's Mss.)
- কড়ি, *s.* (from কড়ে, *to move*), the loins, the hips.
- কড়ে, *a.* (from কড়ে, *to move*), pungent to the taste, acrimonious, fierce, impetuous, fragrant, high-scented, ill-scented, disagreeable, displeasing, envious; *s.* the name of a flower, (*Michelia Champaca*), an improper action, or word, a bilious or over-heated state of body.
- কড়েফ, *s.* (from কড়ে, *pungent*, and ফ, *a word*), affronting or scurrilous language, obscenity, scurrility.
- কড়েফবি, *s.* (from কড়ে, *harsh*, and বি, *harshness*), abusive or scurrilous language.
- কড়েফ, *s.* (from কড়ে, *pungent*), the name of a shrub the bark and seeds of which have a bitter and acrid taste, and are employed as a remedy for dysentery, (*Wrightea antidysenterica*. Brown. Also *Colotropis gigantea*. Brown.)
- কড়েফ, *s.* (from কড়ে, *pungent*), pungency, heat like that of pepper.
- কড়েফ, *s.* (from কড়ে, *harsh*, and ফ, *a gourd*), a bitter gourd.
- কড়েফ, *s.* (from কড়ে, *pungent*), pungency, heat like that of pepper.
- কড়েফ, *s.* (from কড়ে, *pungent*, and ফ, *a word*), scurrilous language.
- কড়েফ, *a.* (from কড়ে, *pungent*, and ফ, *speaking*), scurrilous, provoking.
- কড়েফ, *s.* (from কড়ে, *pungent*, and ফ, *springing up*), the name of a medicinal plant. A compound of black pepper, long pepper, and dried ginger.
- কড়েফ, *s.* (from কড়ে, *pungent*, and ফ, *a speech*), scurrilous and abusive language, provoking language.
- কড়েফ, *s.* (from কড়ে, *pungent*, and ফ, *an answer*), a severe reply, abusive language.
- কড়েফ, *s.* (from কড়ে, *disagreeable*, and ফ, *motion*), the name of a species of hawk.
- কড়েফ, *s.* (from কড়ে, *to rain*, and ফ, *to give*), a cup, a drinking vessel.
- কড়েফ, *s.* an imitative sound meaning a twinging sensation, the sensation of throbbing.

কঠো.

- কঠকটানি, *s.* (from কঠকটে, *a throbbing pain*), the twinging or throbbing of any diseased part.
- কঠকটিয়া, *a.* (from কঠকটে, *a clattering sound*), clattering, making a disagreeable sound.
- কঠকটিয়াবেদী, *s.* (from কঠকটে, *a clattering sound*, and বেদী, *a frog*), the name of a species of frog.
- কঠকিনা, *s.* (from কঠিন, *hard*), difficulty, severity, roughness, unfeelingness, farming at a rack rent.
- কঠকিনাদার, *s.* (from কঠকিনা, *severity*), one who acts roughly or severely, one who performs difficult actions, one who lets land at a rack rent.
- কঠকিনাদারী, *s.* (from কঠকিনাদার, *one who acts severely*), the office or conduct of a severe or rigid person, severity, rigidity, the letting land at a rack rent.
- কঠকীয়া, *s.* (from কঠকটে, *an imitative sound*), the name of a fish which makes a snapping sound when caught; (*Tetrodon levis*. Buchanan's *Miss.*)
- কঠকোবাল, *s.* (from কঠে, *a bond*, and কঠে (কঠে), *a deed of sale*), a conditional bargain or sale in which the buyer binds himself, under certain penalties, if he does not fulfil the conditions of the sale.
- কঠকার, *s.* (from কঠে, *to cut*), a dagger, a poniard.
- কঠেল, *s.* (from কঠে, *pungent*, and এল, *a fruit*), the name of a small tree used in medicine, also the name of another tree, (*Gmelina arborea*.)
- কঠেয়ে, an imitative sound used to express the crumping sound arising from eating dry and hard things, as toasted bread or parched corn.
- কঠিন, *a.* (from কঠে, *to fear*), hard, solid, rigid, harsh, severe, morose, inflexible, austere, unfeeling, difficult, abstruse.
- কঠিনচিত্ত, *a.* (from কঠিন, *unfeeling*, and চিত্ত, *the heart*), hard-hearted, inhuman, unfeeling, morose.
- কঠিনতা, *s.* (from কঠিন, *hard*), hardness, solidity, severity, inflexibility, austerity, relentlessness, difficulty, abstruseness.
- কঠিনতা, *s.* (from কঠিন, *hard*), hardness, solidity, severity, inflexibility, austerity, relentlessness, difficulty, abstruseness.
- কঠিনসময়, *s.* (from কঠিন, *difficult*, and সময়, *time*), a time of difficulty, disagreeable weather.
- কঠিনস্বভাব, *a.* (from কঠিন, *hard*, and স্বভাব, *nature*), cruel, inflexible, hard, severe.
- কঠিনহৃদয়, *a.* (from কঠিন, *hard*, and হৃদয়, *the heart*), hard-hearted, severe, cruel, inflexible, hard.
- কঠিনাভঃকরণ, *a.* (from কঠিন, *hard*, and অভঃকরণ, *the heart*), hard-hearted, severe, cruel, inflexible, hard.
- কঠোর, *a.* (from কঠোর, *hard*), hard, severe, difficult, inflexible, unfeeling, cruel.

- কঠোরতা, *s.* (from কঠোর, *severe*), severity, hardness, harshness, unfeelingness, rigidity.
- কঠোরতা, *s.* (from কঠোর, *severe*), severity, hardness, harshness, unfeelingness, rigidity.
- কড়া, *s.* (from কঠে, *a ring*), the name of a particular kind of bracelet.
- কড়ক, *v. n.* (from কড়িকা, *a socket*), to heal, to assume a healing appearance, to cicatrize. The adverbial participle of this root is frequently constructed with ষে, *to rise up*, and then signifies to heal up, to cicatrize.
- কড়কট, *s.* (from কড়কট, *sea salt*), a superior kind of salt obtained by evaporation.

- কন্দু, *s.* (from কন্দ, *to move*), a sauce pan, a frying-pan.
- কন্দুক, *s.* (from কন্দু, *a bulbous root*), a ball made of flowers tied together.
- কন্দুর, *s.* (from কন্দু, *the head*, and ধু, *to hold*), the neck.
- কন্যা, *s.* (from কন, *to shine*), the sign *Virgo*, a daughter, a virgin, a young woman, a bride. The succotrine aloe, (*Aloe perfoliata*.)
- কন্যাকর্তা, *s.* (from কন্যা, *a virgin*, and কর্তা, *an agent*), the guardian of an unmarried woman who has a right to dispose of her in marriage.
- কন্যাকাল, *s.* (from কন্যা, *a virgin*, and কাল, *time*), the time of youth for a daughter, reckoned by the Hindoos the tenth year of her age, beyond which the delaying of her marriage is accounted dishonourable; the time of virginity.
- কন্যাসত্ত্ব, *a.* (from কন্যা, *a virgin*, and সত্ত্ব, *obtained*), inherent in or belonging to a virgin or unmarried woman.

কপ.

- কন্যাদাতা, *s.* (from কন্যা, *a virgin*, and দাতা, *a giver*), one who gives a young woman in marriage.
- কন্যাদান, *s.* (from কন্যা, *a virgin*, and দান, *a gift*), the gift of a young woman, the giving of a young person in marriage.
- কন্যাভাব, *s.* (from কন্যা, *a virgin*, and ভাব, *a circumstance*), virginity, the condition of an unmarried person.
- কন্যাভাবে, *ad.* (*loc case of কন্যাভাব*), as a daughter, with an expectation or wish to be accounted a daughter.
- কন্যাভার, *s.* (from কন্যা, *a virgin*, and ভার, *a burden*), the burden of a daughter, the charge of a daughter, the expence of marrying a daughter which among the Hindoos is often very considerable.
- কন্যাভারগ্ৰস্ত, *a.* (from কন্যাভার, *the charge of a daughter*, and গ্ৰস্ত, *involved in*), burdened with the care and expence of maintaining or of giving a young woman in marriage.
- কন্যাভারাক্রান্ত, *a.* (from কন্যাভার, *the charge of a daughter*, and আক্রান্ত, *seized by*), burdened with the care and expence of maintaining or of giving a young woman in marriage.
- কন্যাযাত্রী, *s.* (from কন্যা, *a young woman*, and যাত্রিন্, *going*), a guest who attends the bride at a marriage.
- কন্যারাক্ষি, *s.* (from কন্যা, *a virgin*, and রাক্ষি, *a sign of the zodiac*), the sign Virgo.
- কন্যারাক্ষীয়, *a.* (from কন্যারাক্ষি, *Virgo*), shame-faced, timid, effeminate, resembling a young woman.
- কন্যাসম্মুদান, *s.* (from কন্যা, *a virgin*, and সম্মুদান, *a giving*), the giving of a young woman in marriage.
- কপ্, an imitative sound expressive of that which is uttered by some fishes when caught with an angle.
- কপটে, *s.* (from ক, *Bruhman*, and পটে, *to move*), deceit, a trick.
- কপটেতপস্বী, *s.* (from কপটে, *deceit*, and তপস্বিন্, *practising religious austerities*), a pretended ascetic, a religious impostor.
- কপটেতা, *s.* (from কপটে, *deceit*), deceitfulness, knavery.
- কপটেবেশ, *a.* (from কপটে, *deceit*, and বেশ, *a habit*), an assumed character, an assumed part.
- কপটেবেশধারী, *a.* (from কপটেবেশ, *an assumed character*), sustaining an assumed character, acting an assumed part.
- কপটেবেশী, *a.* (from কপটেবেশ, *acting an assumed part*), sustaining an assumed character; *s.* a player.
- কপটী, *a.* (from কপটে, *deceit*), deceitful, acting an assumed part, hypocritical.
- কপটী, *s.* (from ক, *water*, প্, *to nourish*, and দা, *to give*), a name given to the matted hair of Shiva, a cowry.
- কপটীক, *s.* (from কপটী, *a cowry*), a small shell which passes as

- current money throughout the east, (*Cyprea Moneta*).
The matted hair of Shiva.
- কপাটে, *s.* (from ক, *wind*, and পটে, *to move*), a door, a window-shutter.
- কপাটী, *s.* (from কপাটে, *a door*), the operculum of an univalve shell.
- কপাৎ, an imitative sound which is used to express the noise uttered by some fishes when caught by the hook.
- কপাল, *s.* (from ক, *the head*, and পাল, *protecting*), the forehead. This word when used figuratively means destiny, luck, fortune.
- কপালসন্ধি, *s.* (from কপাল, *the forehead*, and সন্ধি, *peace*), a peace made by two parties on equal terms.
- কপালী, *s.* (from কপাল, *the forehead*), a lintel, Shiva, a particular order or cast in society.
- কপালীয়, *a.* (from কপাল, *the forehead*), fortunate, performing the religious duties of that cast of Hindoos called Kupa-tees; in this sense the word is the adjective of those brahmuns who are attached to that cast and perform their religious duties.
- কপি, *s.* (from কপ্, *to tremble*), an ape, a monkey, a pulley; also (from *couve*, Portu.) a cabbage.
- কপিকল, *s.* (from কপি, *a pulley*, and কল, *a machine*), a pulley.
- কপিথ, *s.* (from কপি, *a monkey*, and থা, *to stay*), the name of a fruit tree, (*Feronia Elephantum*).
- কপিয়না, *s.* (from কপি, *a monkey*, and যনা, *a particular shrub*), the name of a large thorny shrub, (*Vangueria spinosa*).
- কপিন, *s.* (from কপি, *a monkey*, and ক, *to take*, or, according to some, from কন্ to desire), the name of a sage who was the founder of the Sankhya philosophy. One of the names of fire; *a.* tawny, monkey brown.
- কপিনী, *s.* (from কপি, *a monkey*, and লী, *to take*), the name of the female elephant which in the Hindoo mythology is fabled as guarding the south east quarter of the world; a cow famous in the fabulous stories of the pooranas; a sort of perfume.
- কপিনীভোগ, *s.* (from কপিনী, *a fabled cow*, and ভোগ, *enjoyment*), the name of a variety of autumnal rice.
- কপিনীরাই, *s.* (from কপিনী, *a fabled cow*, and রাই, *to take*), the name of a variety of autumnal rice.
- কপিনীমক, *s.* (from কপিনী, *a fabled cow*, and মক, *small*), the name of a variety of autumnal rice the grains of which are very small.
- কপিশাক, *s.* (from কপি, *a cabbage*, and শাক, *an esculent vegetable*), a cabbage.
- কপিন, *s.* (from কপীন, *a small garment*), a bit of cloth
