You <b>are</b> my friend.	You' <b>re</b> my teacher.	You <b>are not</b> a student.	You' <b>re not</b> a teacher.
He/She/It <b>is</b> my cat.	He's/She's/It's my dog.	He/She/It <b>is not</b> my dog.	He's/She's/It's <b>not</b> my cat.
We <b>are</b> students.	We' <b>re</b> friends.	We <b>are not</b> sisters.	We' <b>re not</b> sisters.
You <b>are</b> Brazilian.	You' <b>re</b> English.	You <b>are not</b> brothers.	You' <b>re not</b> brothers.
They <b>are</b> my sisters.	They' <b>re</b> my brothers.	They <b>are not</b> teachers.	They' <b>re not</b> teachers.

We use *not* in the negative form.

### Present Simple (*I, you, we, they*): Yes/No Questions and *Wh*- Questions

<i>Wh</i> - Questions	Answers
How old <b>are</b> you?	I' <b>m</b> 13.
What <b>is</b> your surname?	It's Adams.
What <b>is</b> your phone number?	It's 555-6566.
Who <b>is</b> your doctor?	It's Oliver.

We use *wh*- question word + *am/are/is* + subject in the question form.

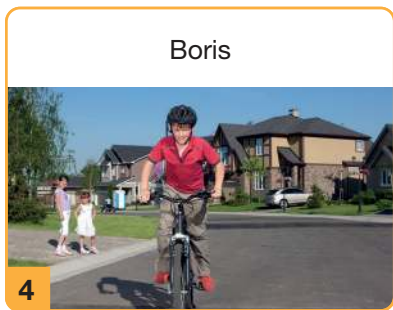
