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The passages listed in this index are from the works mentioned in the Introduction, p. 12, but only those passages are included which are quoted and interpreted in the text. All other references to these and other poets and works are included in the general index.

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Names of medieval authors and their works are included in this index where they are not included in the index of passages discussed. Names of fictional characters are given in the form used in the text, thus distinguishing, for example, between Gauvain (as in Chrétien's romances), Gawein (in Hartmann's), Gawan (in *Parzival*) and Gawain (in *Sir Gawain*). Although Hartmann gives no name to the character called Galoain in Chrétien's *Erec* I have referred to him for the sake of convenience in a reconstructed German form as Galoein.

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
