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The Index covers material in both the main text and the Appendixes. For the Appendixes, reference is given to the English translation rather than to the parallel Latin text, although in most cases the page reference is identical for both. Figures are indicated by the relevant page number followed by “fig.” Proper names have been standardized to English (e.g., “Petrus” becomes “Peter”). Where, however, the individual is reasonably well-known in the literature by a French name, I have kept that name (e.g., “Pierre de Melgeuil” rather than “Peter of Melgeuil”). *Sancti Stephani* is thus translated as “Saint Stephen,” but the cathedral of Agde remains “Saint-Etienne.”

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
