INDEX OF MANUSCRIPTS

In this list will be found all the manuscripts of Polybius referred to in the present study, listed in three sections according to their content; they are arranged in order of age within each section. Appended to each manuscript will be found the name by which it was referred to by Schweighäuser, and references to works which discuss it, omitting those already cited in the text, library catalogues, and the introductions to previous editions. When the references of later editors differ from the names used by Schweighäuser or the sigla of this study, this is also noted.

Letters in bold type are sigla of manuscripts; after the siglum will be found three primary references: the description of the manuscript, preceded by the letter 'd', the passage where its relation to other manuscripts is discussed, preceded by the letter 'r', and a reference to the major stemma in which it is included, preceded by the letter 's'; any other references will follow this information. In addition, the manuscripts from any one library are listed together, the library being referred to under the name of the town where it is situated. In the case of individual libraries, manuscripts with sigla in this study are listed before others which are mentioned. Scribes are referred to by their full names—e.g. 'Andreas Darmarius'—following the practice of Vogel–Gardthausen.
