

Subject Index

This index to particular persons, terms, and subjects is meant to supplement the preceding bibliographical index of George Eliot's sources. Information more directly accessible there is excluded here. In addition, George Eliot's own Index for the Berg Notebook (pp. 210–213) and her lists of the 'Chief Contents' of Pforzheimer 711 (p. 234) and Pforzheimer 707 (p. 437) serve as primary guides to the general subjects most significant to her. As noted in the Preface, most of the section titles listed in the table of Contents (pp. ix to xiii) derive from her index and 'contents' entries. For the alphabetically arranged Pforzheimer 710, a summary of its contents is provided on pp. 390–391.

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
