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INDEX TO THE COMMENTARY

This index is not to be regarded as a concordance, nor is it intended to be complete. Its references are to the places in the Commentary where various words and phrases are discussed. It is not a subject index (and so does not, for example, include references to the discussions in the Commentary of such matters as historical sources, or social and political allusions). It is an index to the vocabulary of Dekker's dramatic works.

For the words and phrases in the following list, reference is ordinarily given to but a single point in the Commentary, where further examples of their usage in Dekker's dramatic as well as his non-dramatic works are assembled. Sometimes, however, the Commentary contains information in more than one place that bears on a given word or phrase, in which cases additional index references are given. Where more than one reference is given, the form of the lemma as concerns spelling and capitalization is that of the first reference. Words and phrases printed in italics in the text are printed in roman in the index. 'S.D.' (unitalicized) following act-, scene- and line-numbers refers to a stage direction occurring within a line divided among more than one speaker. Explanatory glosses are ordinarily not given for index entries, but are provided only when a single word is used with more than one meaning, or when the entry is of an oddity (as in the case of exclamations) or used in such a special sense as to warrant some degree of identification; on such occasions, the identifying comment is provided in square brackets. In preparing an index to the Commentary on an old-spelling text, I felt it unadvisable to modernize the spelling of entries, though the orthographic inconsistencies of the old editions have inevitably resulted in certain irregularities in the listing of identical words.

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
