PREFACE

This monograph is a revised version of Part II of my doctoral dissertation submitted to the University of Cambridge in 1975. The transcription of place-names is a familiar problem to workers in this field, and I have adopted the following policy here. Where there is a well-known English form, as with Biblical names, I have used this; where there is not, I have reproduced the name in an Anglicised form which keeps as close as possible to the original, without, generally, employing the diacritical marks that would be needed for absolute precision. With the help of the maps there should be no difficulty in establishing what site is meant, and specialists will know where to find the exact spelling. I dedicate this work to my parents, in gratitude for the opportunities and encouragement which they have so freely given me.




- I The Sinai Peninsula and adjacent areas. (*Ancient names are in capitals.*)


