## ABBREVIATIONS

- MW*      *The Miscellaneous Works of Thomas Arnold.*
- QJEd*     *Quarterly Journal of Education.*
- SL*       Letter in *Stanley's Life of Thomas Arnold D.D.*  
 Teachers' Edition 1901. The initials (SL) are followed by the number of the letter, date and the relevant page. It should be noted that the numbering of the letters differs from that in the first edition of 1844. Thus letter no. LXV in volume 1 of the 1844 edition becomes LXXVI in 1901. Similarly letter no. XCVIII of volume 2 of the 1844 edition becomes no. CXIII in 1901. The 1901 edition, in spite of its faults, has been chosen for reference purposes here because it is easily the most readily available of all editions. A further complication arises in the version edited by G. T. Bettany (undated) for the Minerva Library of Famous Books, based on the sixth edition, and given the original title: *The Life and Correspondence of Thomas Arnold D.D.* by Arthur Penrhyn Stanley. Five letters additional to those of the 1901 edition appear in this volume. The reader will find it easier, unless the 1901 edition is to hand, to trace letters by using the date of the letter concerned rather than the other information.
- Sermons*    The volume number of the sermons refers to the 1878 collected edition. See the bibliography for the relationship of the 1878 volumes to the original (unnumbered) editions.
