*American Fiction, 1901–1925: A Bibliography* is an invaluable record of first printings of American fiction for scholars of American literature, readers of fiction, and collectors of modern first editions. Over three hundred fifty print and online reference sources have been reviewed to approach, as nearly as possible, a comprehensive listing of titles that fit the bibliography's criteria. Each title entry includes rare book bibliographic description as prescribed by the Library of Congress's *Descriptive Cataloging of Rare Books*. Short story collections are included with complete listing of contents. When available, notation is made of copyright dates and publication announcements in *Publisher's Weekly*. Bibliographic notations for British printings of entries are acknowledged if they appear in the *British Library Catalogue*. Citations of standard authoritative sources (e.g., *Bibliography of American Literature*) are included.

The bibliography will assist all levels of research into the examination of the literary record of American cultural history and will augment, beyond literary studies, historical, political, religious and popular studies. The bibliography will also assist research in the growing areas of African-American, women's, and ethnic studies.

## Preface

*American Fiction, 1901-1925: A Bibliography* is a compilation of first printings of original fiction for adults by American authors published in the United States from 1901 through 1925. This current volume has been generally arranged and styled in the tradition of Lyle Wright's contribution to the earlier American fiction bibliography (*American Fiction, 1774-1900*, 3 vols.)<sup>1</sup>, although the format and content have been altered to accommodate current scholarly research. For instance, publisher's and illustrator's indices have been added in response to the increased interest in the history of the book and the book arts. Still, the principal criteria for selection of titles in the bibliography remain true to Wright's and include "novels, novelettes, romances, short stories, tall tales, tract-like tales, allegories, and fictitious biographies and travels, in prose." (Exceptions are noted below.)

The first quarter of the twentieth century was, in many ways, a period of transition in American fiction. Among major authors, the period began with the late works of the nineteenth-century masters of realism (Howells, James, and Twain) and ended with the early works of the post-World War I, "lost generation" (Dos Passos, Fitzgerald, and Hemingway). Some writers flourished through most of the period (Cather, Dreiser, Glasgow, and Wharton), while the brilliant careers of others were cut short by death (Crane, Norris, and London). The period is particularly valuable for research in African-American studies, feminist criticism and the popular culture movement. Charles W. Chesnutt, W. E. B. DuBois, and Jean Toomer preceded the Harlem Renaissance and brought early national attention to black writers. Mary Wilkins Freeman, Dorothy Canfield Fisher, and Charlotte Perkins Gilman considered the problems of working women, marriage and divorce and female identity. David Graham Phillips, Robert Herrick, Upton Sinclair, and Jacob A. Riis were among the muckrakers and socialists who confronted the political, economic, and social issues of the period. Anna Katherine Green, Mary Roberts Rinehart, Jacques Futrelle, and Edgar Rice Burroughs were among the many early practitioners who developed the popular narrative genre of mystery and science fiction.

Of course, the majority of writers approached social and cultural issues with less insight, and often less tolerance, than most prominent writers, but knowledge of their views is equally important for a complete understanding of American beliefs and values. Arguably, many less recognized writers, as distinct from their more critically appreciated contemporaries, may have presented a more accurate assessment of the majority American view toward controversial political and social issues. The body of popular fiction, then, is an invaluable source of interdisciplinary and special studies of American culture history, in addition to its importance for the purely literary studies of particular authors and titles.

As noted above, every effort has been made to note the first printing of those titles that meet the selection criteria. Revised editions are listed if the work underwent extensive change, but not superficial additions, as in the proverbial added introduction or preface common to so many "revised" editions. The first, separate book publication of a short story is included, even if it appeared in an earlier collection or anthology. Retitled works are noted under the first title and cross-referenced accordingly in the bibliography and in the title index.

*American Fiction, 1901-1925: A Bibliography* omits many of the same classifications as Lyle Wright, including juveniles, folklore, collections of anecdotes, essays, and periodicals. Additionally, this volume omits series fiction on the grounds that series fiction is more a product of a manufacturer, i.e., carefully monitored, formula fiction, than the individual product of a creator or co-creator.

## BIBLIOGRAPHICAL COMMENT

The goal of the bibliography is to provide reliable research information for scholars of American cultural history, students of the book arts, and collectors. The bibliographic entries are arranged alphabetically by author. Anonymous works will be arranged alphabetically by title within the author sequence. Multiple titles by a single author will be arranged alphabetically by title under the author's name.

## THE DESCRIPTIVE RECORD

**Citation:** each entry will be cited by the first letter of the main entry (author or title) and progressive, numerical indication of alphabetical order, e.g., A-1, A-2, A-3 . . . A-385, A-386; B-1, B-2, B-3 . . . B-700, B-701, B-702, etc.

**Main entry:** when available, author's names are listed according to the name authority as prescribed by The Program for Cooperative Cataloging of the Library of Congress; otherwise, name authority is established according to conventions of the *Anglo-American Cataloguing Rules, 2nd revised edition*. When available, birth and death dates are given. For each entry, the complete title, including sub-title, is recorded. The statement of responsibility (i.e., author's name) is recorded as printed on the title page and may vary from the author main entry. Illustrators' names or statements on illustrations are also recorded.

**Imprint:** the city of publication, publisher, and date of publication follow the statement of responsibility. Information derived from other than the title page will be bracketed (i.e., [ ]).

**Pagination:** the last numbered page of narrative text is recorded and may be followed by the bracketed notation of remaining unnumbered pages of narrative text, e.g., [1] or [2], etc. Frontispieces (front.), plates and illustrations are recorded. Particular note is made of photographic plates (photo. plates) and portraits (port.). Illustrators or photographers not acknowledged in the statement of responsibility are listed in brackets following illustration information, e.g., [Ill. by Edward C. Caswell.].

**Copy specific notation:** unless otherwise indicated, copies examined for this bibliography are from the William Charvat Collection of American Fiction at the Ohio State University Libraries. Examined copies from other libraries are designated by their OCLC (Online Computer Library Center) three letter code, e.g., DLC (Library of Congress), NYP (New York Public Library), etc. In some cases, copies are examined from both the Charvat Collection and another library and the dual examination is noted, e.g., OSU, DLC. A list of OCLC symbols appears in the prefatory matter. Unexamined copies are noted with reference to the source of the bibliographic description, e.g., "Unexamined copy, bibliographic data from NUC" (i.e., National Union Catalog).

**Special notes:** incidental information cited from the book, such as earlier periodical appearance, may be noted.

**Cover titles:** cover titles and other alternative titles used in the book are noted.

**Contents:** the entire contents are noted for short story collections by a single author and for most anthologies. Individual short story titles are listed in the title index. The first book appearance of a short story is cross-referenced in the bibliography.

**Publishing history:** the Library of Congress *Catalog of Copyright Entries* (LC), *Publishers' Weekly* weekly announcements (PW), and brief records from the *British Library Catalog* (BLC) are noted, e.g., LC: O 16, '23.

**References:** standard reference sources, which include additional descriptive information, appear at the end of the entry, e.g. BAL (Bibliography of American Literature). The list of references appears in the prefatory matter.

Cross references exist for name variants, joint authors, editors, title changes, and other variant editions. Pseudonym index, title index, illustrator index, and publisher index appear in the back matter.
