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ERRATUM

The last line of the scale of fines and imprisonments on page 55 should read:

Exceeds £20 3 cal. months.

But it is submitted that the practical effect of s. 15 (1) of the C. J. A. Act, 1914, is to give the Justices power to inflict a fine of £50 with the alternative of six months imprisonment.

Moreover, by s. 53 of the S. J. Act, 1879, in the case of offences against the laws relating to the Inland Revenue and Customs, where the penalty exceeds £50, the imprisonment on non-payment, or default of distress, may exceed three, but must not exceed six, months.
