

TOPOGRAPHICAL INDEX

The figure in parentheses following each name indicates the district in which it is located. In the case of names marked on the maps in this book, there follows an indication of the 10-km square in which it is to be found. This is done by citing the grid-lines numbered in the margin of the map: thus 130/210 for Abbey Hill indicates that it is in the square bounded on the west by grid-line 130 and on the south by grid-line 210. In the case of names not marked on our maps a conventional grid-reference is given, by which they can be easily located on the $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch Ordnance Survey maps, but to save readers the necessity of referring to a $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch map we also give an indication of compass-bearing and distance from a place which is given on the maps in this book.

Nearly all the place-names used are to be found on the $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch maps; those few that are not are indicated by an asterisk.
