Place names are given according to normal English usage or as on the Maps; linguistic variants and modern forms are shown in brackets e.g. Eger (Cheb); Bozen (Bolzano). Non-dramatic medieval texts and dramatic works from the modern period are included here but for early play-texts *see* the bibliographical index of plays.
