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Noel Butlin died before completing the full account. What is included in this book is the material as he left it, taking into account various corrections, ambiguities, checking and bibliographical amendments. The picture is complete except for an account of the first major depression in Australia, the economic collapse of the 1840s. The notes to the beginning of that chapter sketch out the intended direction of the analysis, and preface the incomplete material that he left. The material and its suggestions for further work are left for other scholars of Australian economic history to take up.

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Note: While every effort has been made to provide accurate references (in the text) and sources (for the tables and figures), a number of these were incomplete at the time of the author's death and have not been able to be located.
