

Acts of charity have generally been interpreted as a response to socio-economic conditions or to spiritual and ideological movements. In *Charity and power in early modern Italy* the focus shifts from these impersonal forces to the everyday experiences of benefactors, from collective mentalities to subjectivity.

Drawing extensively on archival material, this study analyses the tensions within the individuals' personal and political milieus and shows that power and gender conflicts within the world of the elites were a crucial factor in encouraging charitable giving and even in shaping perceptions of the deserving poor. Special attention is given to the symbolic and metaphorical significance of charity rather than to the explicit aims of charitable activity.

Through its examination of a city marginal to the Italian tradition of communes and city-states and its concern with a relatively under-investigated period of Italian history, the book offers an extended reassessment of what has hitherto been regarded as the typical Italian model of welfare.

Money1

The main unit of currency was the *fiorino* (divisible into 12 *grossi*, divisible in turn into 4 *quarti*) up to 1632, when it was replaced by the *lira* (divisible into 20 *soldi*).

Other units referred to

scudo: before 1600 it was worth 8 to 13 *fiorini*; in the following decades its value soared as a result of heavy inflation up to 35 *fiorini* in 1632. After this date its value oscillated between 3,5 and 9 *lire*.

ducatone: it was worth 12 to 19 fiorini before 1632, and 2,5 to 6 lire in the following period.

doppia: two scudi
