PREFACE

The Plumpton letter collection, the least well known of the four early collections of English letters, precedes by more than a century other Northern collections of lay correspondence. Not only a unique source for Northern history, it is of value for political, social and legal history generally. The present edition, made possible by the rediscovery of the main text, contains material unavailable to Thomas Stapleton, whose edition of 1839, though remarkable for its date, is by present standards deficient in many respects, and may have obscured the interest, significance and value of the texts.

I am deeply grateful to Mr G. C. F. Forster and Mr John Taylor of the University of Leeds for checking the text and for their most generous help in many ways; also to Professor M. W. Beresford for bringing material to my notice. I am indebted too to Mr Robert Frost, Archivist to the Joint Committee of the West Yorkshire Archive Service, and to Mr W.J. Connor, Archivist to the Leeds District Archives, for making a photocopy of the Plumpton Letter Book available to me for transcription, and for permission to include the transcripts of this and other material in the present edition; also to Mr Brett Harrison and the staff of the Leeds District Archives for their willing help, and to Mrs Sylvia Thomas, Archivist to the Yorkshire Archaeological Society, whose Council has authorized the inclusion of material from the Society's collections. The Keeper of Western Manuscripts in the Bodleian Library and the Curator of the Manuscript Collections in the British Library have kindly granted permission for the inclusion of transcripts of material from these collections.




