Index

Total consistency in creating an index which incorporates large numbers of the French *noblesse* would be both difficult to achieve, and in many cases counter-intuitive. For the lower ranks of the nobility, and especially the *noblesse de robe*, I have usually indexed the individuals under family names rather than seigneurial titles – hence Jean *Choisy*, sr de Beaumont, or Jean-Baptiste *Bretagne*, marquis de Courcy. However, there are some cases where such persons were clearly identified by their seigneurial title in contemporary correspondence and by subsequent historians, such that it would be perverse not to use this title: René Voyer, sr d'*Argenson*, Léon le Bouthillier, comte de *Chavigny* (yet, at a similar social level, Claude *Bullion*, not marquis de Gallardon). On a few occasions where confusion may be generated by this I have cross-referenced family name and seigneurial titles. At the level of the *grands*, indexing by (most prestigious) title tends to be the lesser of two evils, precluding some of the confusion over different generations of the family with similar names – maréchal *Créqui* was recognized by contemporaries and subsequent historians in a way that 'Charles de *Blanchefort*' is not. In the case of sovereign families, I have adopted the convention of indexing under first names: Charles VIII, king of France, Carlo Emmanuele I, duke of Savoy.
