**T-S AS 1.1**

Ecclesiastes 5:17–6:3

Hebrew; predominantly standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Magna on *verso* and Masorah Parva; paper; 18.4 × 14; 1 leaf; 13 lines; mutilated with many pieces of text missing.

Examples of non-standard vocalization are: - for  $\text{ֿ}$ ,  $\text{ֿ}$  and  $\text{ֿ}$ ;  $\text{ֿ}$  for  $\text{ֿ}$ ,  $\text{ֿ}$  and -;  $\text{ֿ}$  for  $\text{ֿ}$ ; -1 for -; the unusual use of *dagesh* in  $\text{ֿֿֿֿ}$  at Ecclesiastes 6:2. Decorative line-endings are used.

**T-S AS 1.2**

Deuteronomy 32:20–24

Hebrew; unvocalized, but with verse divisions on *verso*; paper; 6.1 × 7.4; 1 leaf; 5 lines (incomplete); mutilated.

There is poetic spacing. [2]

**T-S AS 1.3**

Biblical passages.

Hebrew; unvocalized, but with verse divisions; paper; 13.2 × 11.2; 1 leaf; 16 lines; mutilated with many pieces of text missing.

The text comprises the following passages:

*recto*: Micah 6:8; Isaiah 3:10; 14:27; Deuteronomy 10:17;

2 Chronicles 19:7; Deuteronomy 3:24; 1 Samuel 2:2–3;

*verso*: Ecclesiastes 9:12; 11:5–8; Judaeo-Arabic liturgical rubric  $\text{ֿֿֿֿ}$ ; Deuteronomy 10:17.

The tetragrammaton is abbreviated to  $\text{ֿֿ}$ . [3]

**T-S AS 1.4**

Isaiah 3:10; Ecclesiastes 7:1–9

Hebrew; unvocalized, but with verse divisions; paper; 12.9 × 9.5; 1 leaf; 15 lines; mutilated with many pieces of text missing.

*Verso* contains only mirrored text. [4]

**T-S AS 1.5**

Exodus 36:37; 37:16

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated, Masorah Magna; vellum; 10.3 × 12.2; 1 leaf; 2 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated with only a few words preserved. [5]

**T-S AS 1.6**

Genesis 15:12–13; 15:20–16:1; 16:7–8; 16:15–17:1

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; vellum; 7.7 × 8.7; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 8 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated and rubbed with only small pieces of text preserved.

On *recto* at Genesis 16:1 there is a decorated  $\text{ֿ}$ . [6]

**T-S AS 1.7**

Deuteronomy 17:20–18:3; 18:6–9

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Magna; vellum; 6.9 × 10.5; 1 leaf; 6 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated with only small pieces of text preserved.

On *recto* in the top right-hand corner there is a decorated  $\text{ֿ}$ , probably a quire number. [7]

**T-S AS 1.8**

Exodus 35:34–35; 36:2; 36:10–11

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where preserved, cantillated; vellum; 12.2 × 7.4; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 5 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated and rubbed with only a few words preserved. [8]

**T-S AS 1.9**

Leviticus 1:2–3; 1:5–7

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; vellum; 10.5 × 11.5; 1 leaf; 4 lines (incomplete); mutilated and rubbed with pieces of text missing. [9]

**T-S AS 1.10**

Genesis 33:10–34:7

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where legible, cantillated; vellum; 16.5 × 13.2; 1 leaf; 15 lines; mutilated and rubbed with many pieces of text missing or illegible.

The sign  $\text{ֿ}$  or  $\text{ֿ}$  is used to fill up line-endings. [10]

**T-S AS 1.11**

Deuteronomy 29:17–19; 30:14–17

Hebrew; unvocalized; vellum; 10.4 × 10.8; 1 leaf; 12 lines (incomplete); mutilated and rubbed with many pieces of text missing.

The sign  $\text{ֿ}$  is used to fill up line-endings on *verso*. [11]

**T-S AS 1.12**

Genesis 48:8–13

Hebrew; unvocalized; vellum; 11.7 × 7.1; 1 leaf, part of a scroll; 11 lines; mutilated with many pieces of text missing. [12]

**T-S AS 1.13**

Leviticus 1:2–3

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where preserved, uncantillated; vellum; 9.6 × 11.7; 1 leaf; 4 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated with only a few words preserved.

The tetragrammaton is abbreviated to  $\text{ֿֿ}$ . *Verso* is blank. [13]

**T-S AS 1.14**

2 Chronicles 15:8; 16:1; 16:10–11; 17:7

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Parva on *verso*; vellum; 6.4 × 14; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 3 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated with only small pieces of text preserved.

$\text{ֿֿֿֿ}$  is written in the upper margin on both sides of the leaf. [14]

**T-S AS 1.15**

Hebrew liturgical poetry; vellum.

**T-S AS 1.17**

1 Samuel 3:6–15; 3:17–4:6

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; vellum; 30.1 × 10.2; 1 leaf; 21 lines (incomplete); mutilated with many pieces of text missing.

On *verso* at 1 Samuel 3:19 there is a decorated  $\text{D}$  and at 1 Samuel 3:21 there is another with the Judaeo-Arabic phrase  $\text{כִּי הַרְחַק}$ , 'thus far', written beside it in a different ink from that used for the main text. [17]

**T-S AS 1.18**

Genesis 1:2; 1:5–7

Hebrew; parts of the text have Tiberian vocalization and cantillation, but much of it is unvocalized; vellum; 8.6 × 11.5; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 8 lines (incomplete); mutilated and rubbed with many pieces of text missing.

*Verso* is blank. [18]

**T-S AS 1.19**

Psalms 70:3–71:1; 72:16–20

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Parva; vellum; 12.6 × 12.3; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 9 lines (incomplete); mutilated and rubbed with pieces of text missing.

There is poetic spacing. [19]

**T-S AS 1.20**

Leviticus 5:15–22

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; vellum; 11.6 × 12.5; 1 leaf; 10 lines; badly mutilated and rubbed with many pieces of text missing.

The tetragrammaton is abbreviated to  $\text{יה}$ . [20]

**T-S AS 1.21**

Numbers 22:13; 22:37–38

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; vellum; 4.2 × 4.3; 1 leaf; 6 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated and rubbed with only a few words preserved. [21]

**T-S AS 1.22**

Numbers 22:14–17; 22:20–21; 22:34–36; 22:38–23:1

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; vellum; 11.2 × 12.4; 1 leaf; 2 columns (incomplete); 12 lines (incomplete); mutilated and rubbed with many pieces of text missing or illegible.

The sign  $\text{v}$  is used to fill up a line-ending on *recto*. [22]

**T-S AS 1.23**

Numbers 32:27–29; 32:37–40

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; vellum; 6.4 × 8.1; 1 leaf; 6 lines (incomplete); mutilated and rubbed with many pieces of text missing or illegible. [23]

**T-S AS 1.24**

Jeremiah 22:28–29; 23:2–3

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Parva; vellum; 10.4 × 10.1; 1 leaf; 7 lines (incomplete); mutilated and rubbed with pieces of text missing. [24]

**T-S AS 1.25**

Hebrew fragment, Passover liturgy, including Exodus 12:27; vellum. [25]

**T-S AS 1.26**

Genesis 2:5–7

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where legible, cantillated; vellum; 7.1 × 5.9; 1 leaf; 6 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated and rubbed with only a few words on one side of the leaf preserved legibly. [26]

**T-S AS 1.27**

Deuteronomy 4:22–23; 4:32–33

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where legible, cantillated; Masorah Magna and Parva; vellum; 10.8 × 7.4; 1 leaf; 5 lines (incomplete); mutilated and rubbed with many pieces of text missing.

There is a catchword on *verso*. [27]

**T-S AS 1.28**

Genesis 2:3–5

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where legible, cantillated; vellum; 7.3 × 6.4; 1 leaf; 9 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated and rubbed with the text on only one side of the leaf preserved legibly. [28]

**T-S AS 1.29**

2 Kings 8:13–16; 8:18–22

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Parva on *verso*; paper; 17.5 × 12.9; 1 leaf; 10 lines (incomplete); mutilated and rubbed with many pieces of text missing. [29]

**T-S AS 1.30**

Psalms 104:30–35; 105:12–20

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Parva on *verso*; vellum; 11.9 × 8.5; 1 leaf; 12 lines (incomplete); mutilated with many pieces of text missing.

There is poetic spacing. [30]

**T-S AS 1.31**Genesis 5:3–4 and part of a repeated phrase on *verso*.

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Parva on *verso*; vellum; 5.1 × 9; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 3 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated with only a few words preserved. [31]

## T-S AS 1.32 — T-S AS 1.46

**T-S AS 1.32**

Exodus 30:34–35; 31:18

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Parva on *verso*; vellum; 7.4 × 7; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 5 lines (incomplete); mutilated with many pieces of text missing.

On *recto*, probably opposite Exodus 31:1, which has not been preserved, there is a decorated □. [32]

**T-S AS 1.33**

Exodus 31:6; 31:11

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Parva on *recto*; vellum; 5.6 × 12; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 2 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated with only a few words preserved. [33]

**T-S AS 1.34**

Exodus 16:14–15; 17:2–3

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where legible, cantillated; vellum; 9.3 × 7.3; 1 leaf; 5 lines; mutilated and rubbed with pieces of text missing or illegible. [34]

**T-S AS 1.35**

Psalms 106:26–28; 106:47–48; 107:22–23; 108:2–5

Hebrew; unvocalized; vellum; 6 × 7.7; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 5 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated and rubbed with only small pieces of text preserved. [35]

**T-S AS 1.36**

Ezekiel 37:23–28; 1 Kings 2:1–2

Hebrew; unvocalized, but with verse divisions; paper; 18.4 × 13.6; 1 leaf; 12 lines; mutilated and rubbed with pieces of text missing or illegible.

The text comprises parts of the *haftarot* for *sedarim* 11–12 with traces of a liturgical rubric on *verso* before 1 Kings 2:1. On *recto* in the top right-hand corner there is a decorated 7, probably a quire number. [36]

**T-S AS 1.37**

Isaiah 19:24; 20:6–21:3; 21:9–12; 22:2

Hebrew; predominantly standard Tiberian, cantillated; vellum; 18.1 × 26; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 8 lines (incomplete); mutilated with many pieces of text missing.

Examples of non-standard vocalization are:  $\dot{\nu}$  for  $\nu$  and  $\dot{\nu}$  ;  $\dot{\nu}$  for  $\nu$  ;  $\dot{\nu}$  for  $\nu$  . [37]

**T-S AS 1.38**

Genesis 44:14–18; 44:20–23; 44:26–27

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Magna and Parva; vellum; 16.3 × 16.3; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 8 lines (incomplete); mutilated with pieces of text missing.

On *recto* at Genesis 44:18, the beginning of *sefer* 11, there is a decorated *parashah* heading. [38]

**T-S AS 1.39**

Psalms 119:81–103

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; vellum; 13.2 × 15.7; 1 leaf; 10 lines; mutilated with pieces of text missing. [39]

**T-S AS 1.40**

Exodus 5:10–14; 5:17–22; 6:18–23; 6:26–30

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where legible, cantillated; vellum; 18.5 × 16.2; 1 leaf; 2 columns (incomplete); 21 lines (incomplete); mutilated and rubbed with many pieces of text missing or illegible. [40]

**T-S AS 1.41**

Leviticus 9:5–6; 9:16–17

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where legible, cantillated; vellum; 7.8 × 7.6; 1 leaf; 1 column (incomplete); 5 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated and rubbed with only a few small pieces of text preserved.

The sign  $\nu$  is used to fill up line-endings. [41]

**T-S AS 1.42**

Leviticus 9:6–15; 9:17–18

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where legible, cantillated; vellum; 15.9 × 11.5; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 14 lines (complete); mutilated and rubbed with pieces of text missing.

The sign  $\nu$  is used to fill up line-endings. [42]

**T-S AS 1.43**

Genesis 40:5–7; 40:11–13

Hebrew; predominantly standard Tiberian, cantillated; vellum; 4.8 × 7.9; 1 leaf; 6 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated with only small pieces of text preserved.

Examples of non-standard vocalization are:  $\dot{\nu}$  for  $\nu$  and  $\dot{\nu}$  ;  $\dot{\nu}$  for  $\nu$  . [43]

**T-S AS 1.44**

Genesis 11:16–21

Hebrew; unvocalized, but with verse divisions; vellum; 16.3 × 11.8; 1 leaf; 7 lines (incomplete); mutilated with pieces of text missing. [44]

**T-S AS 1.45**

Jeremiah 12:17–13:2; 13:20–21; 19:11–13; 20:10–12

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Parva on folio 2r; vellum; 16.9 × 18.7; 2 leaves conjoined; 10 lines (incomplete); mutilated with pieces of text missing. [45]

**T-S AS 1.46**

Genesis 20:13–15; 20:17–18

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Parva on *verso*; vellum; 17.7 × 9.6; 1 leaf; 9 lines (incomplete); mutilated with many pieces of text missing.

## T-S AS 1.46 — T-S AS 1.61

**[T-S AS 1.46, continued]**

On *verso* there is a decorated  $\Theta$  beside the point where Genesis 21:1, which has been lost through mutilation, would have been written. [46]

**T-S AS 1.47**

Catena of biblical passages.

Hebrew; Tiberian, uncantillated, rubricated; vellum; 13.6 × 7.9; 1 leaf; 15 lines; badly mutilated and rubbed with many pieces of text missing.

The text on one side of the leaf includes:

Psalms 15:1 (?); 46:8 or 12; 143:1; 69:14; 90:1 (?); Jonah 2:3; Psalms 40:13.

The text on the other side of the leaf includes:

Deuteronomy 3:24; Psalms 42:9; 90:1; 145:19. [47]

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Parva; vellum; 8.6 × 12.3; 1 leaf; 1 column (incomplete); 7 lines (incomplete); mutilated with pieces of text missing.

The non-standard vocalization  $\text{ , }$  for  $\text{ , }$  occurs. [49]

**T-S AS 1.50**

Leviticus 8:4–5; 8:7

Hebrew; Tiberian on part of *recto*, but most of the text is unvocalized; vellum; 9.1 × 10.7; 1 leaf; 3 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated with only a few words preserved. [50]

**T-S AS 1.51**

2 Kings 18:6–7; 18:12–13; 18:17–18

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where preserved, cantillated; vellum; 8.7 × 15.3; 1 leaf; 2 columns (incomplete); 4 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated with only a few letters preserved.

$\text{לִיְהוָה שְׂדֵדִי}$  is written in the upper margin on both sides of the leaf. [51]

**T-S AS 1.52**

Deuteronomy 15:16–18; 15:21–16:3; 16:7–11; 16:15–16

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated, Masorah Magna and Parva on *recto*; vellum; 14.9 × 13.5; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 13 lines (incomplete); mutilated and rubbed with many pieces of text missing or illegible. [52]

**T-S AS 1.53**

1 Samuel 21:10–11; 21:16; 22:5; 22:8

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where preserved; cantillated; Masorah Parva; vellum; 11.2 × 8.8; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 8 lines

(incomplete); badly mutilated and rubbed with only small pieces of text preserved. [53]

**T-S AS 1.54**

Unidentified Hebrew Bible fragment with Masorah Parva; vellum. [54]

**T-S AS 1.55**

Unidentified Hebrew Bible fragment with Masorah Magna; vellum. [55]

**T-S AS 1.56**

Psalms 143:2–144:11

Hebrew; unvocalized, but with verse divisions; vellum; 10.7 × 4.4; 1 leaf; 12 lines; mutilated with many pieces of text missing. [56]

**T-S AS 1.57**

Isaiah 53:7–9; 53:12–54:1

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where preserved, cantillated; Masorah Parva; vellum; 12.8 × 12.4; 1 leaf; 8 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated and rubbed with only small pieces of text preserved. [57]

**T-S AS 1.58**

Numbers 11:10–14; 11:16–23; 11:26–29; 11:32–12:1; 12:4–8

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where legible, cantillated; Masorah Magna and Parva; vellum; 22 × 17.5; 1 leaf; 3 columns; 18 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated and rubbed with many pieces of text missing or illegible.

On *recto* at Numbers 11:23 there is a decorated  $\Theta$ . [58]

**T-S AS 1.59**

Psalms 112:1–113:1; 113:5–114:6

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; vellum; 14 × 11.4; 1 leaf; 13 lines (incomplete); mutilated with many pieces of text missing.

There is poetic spacing. [59]

**T-S AS 1.60**

Numbers 22:4; 22:8; 22:15–17; 22:22–23; 22:28; 22:34

Hebrew; standard Tiberian where legible, cantillated; Masorah Magna; vellum; 8.1 × 24; 1 leaf; 3 columns; 4 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated and rubbed with only small pieces of text preserved. [60]

**T-S AS 1.61**

1 Samuel 9:18–20; 9:24–26

Hebrew; standard Tiberian, cantillated; Masorah Magna and Parva; vellum; 20 × 15.4; 1 leaf; 2 columns; 10 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated and rubbed with many pieces of text missing.

1 Chronicles 13:13–14; 15:13–15

Hebrew; Tiberian, cantillated, but barely legible; vellum; 6.9 × 6.1; 1 leaf; 5 lines (incomplete); badly mutilated and rubbed with only small pieces of text preserved.

Unidentified Hebrew Bible fragment with traces of text in two columns, probably related to T-S AS 1.61; vellum.

There is poetic spacing.
