- Note 1: This index focuses on legal issues and on the arbitral and judicial decisions under consideration. Parties' arguments, facts and ancillary documents are indexed only to the extent they are essential to an understanding of the legal issues. It has been designed in such a way as to be amenable to developing ICSID case law, so far as appropriate adopting the terminology of the index to C. H. Schreuer, *The ICSID Convention: A Commentary* (Cambridge University Press, 2001).
- *Note* 2: For procedural points reference should be made to the ICSID Convention (1965) by Article and the ICSID Rules headings. References are included under subject headings only where the point at issue is the subject of debate.
- *Note 3*: References to cases are to substantial discussion of those cases, not to the original report of the case.
- Note 4: State immunity entries are listed under the separate headings of State immunity from execution/attachment and State immunity from jurisdiction only when it is clear that they apply in that particular context. Where the same principles apply in both cases they appear under the general heading 'State immunity'.
- Note 5: Dates of treaties normally refer to the date of signature, not entry into force.

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
