

# INDEX

Roman names in the index are ordered by *nomina* followed by their *RE* numbers. After the full nomenclature, representative magistracies held (if any) are listed in parentheses (generally the highest annual office the individual attained). Exiles have an additional element to their listing below: a boldface number (e.g., **no. 5**) indicating the person's sequential entry in Chapter 6 (Prosopography of Roman Exiles). Note that Emperors are only listed by the common anglicized form of their name. Material within entries is chronological whenever possible for persons, and alphabetical otherwise. Footnotes are referenced only where the subject is not mentioned in the corresponding page of text.
