

## FAULKNER'S CARTOGRAPHIES OF CONSCIOUSNESS

William Faulkner continues to be an author who is widely read, studied, and admired. This book provides an interdisciplinary account of his legacy, one that speaks to the antiracism discourse of our own time and presents concerns about the development of subjecthood in a technologically saturated culture. Combining literary critique with network and complexity science, this study offers a new reading of William Faulkner as a novelist for the information age.
