

THE REBIRTH OF TERRITORY

The concept of territory is central in international law, but a detailed analysis of how the concept is used in both discourse and practice has been lacking until now. Rather than reproducing the established understanding of territoriality within the international legal order, this study suggests that the discipline of international law relies on an outmoded spatial paradigm. Gail Lythgoe argues for a complete overhaul of our understanding of territory, to engage more effectively with key processes, structures, and actors relevant to contemporary global law and governance. In this new theoretical account of an essential aspect of public international law, she argues that territory is a dynamic social reality created by the exercise of power. Territories are constituted by the practices of a more diverse array of actors than is acknowledged. Mapping the reassembling of functions, Lythgoe argues these new spaces are being constituted by state and non-state actors alike.
