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If a chapter is devoted entirely or largely to a topic or a philosopher, and if that fact is evident from the title of the chapter, the index entry for that topic (that philosopher) does not contain references to the pages on which that chapter appears. For example, the entries “ontological commitment” and “Alston, W. P.” contain no references to the pages 137–152. That the reader interested in ontological commitment (or in Alston) should consult these pages is made sufficiently evident by the title “Alston on Ontological Commitment.”

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
