Christianity in the Second Century shows how academic study on this critical period of Christian development has undergone substantial change over the last thirty years. The second century is often considered to be a time during which the Christian church moved relentlessly towards forms of institutionalization and consolidated itself against so-called heretics. However, new perspectives have been introduced as the period has attracted interest from a variety of disciplines, including not only early Christian studies but also ancient Judaism and the wider world of early imperial scholarship. This book seeks to reflect this changed scholarly landscape, and with contributions from key figures in these recent re-evaluations, it aims to enrich and stimulate further discussion.
