- Then ask some volunteers to read some sentences out loud. The rest of the class answers true or false.

3. Write about your favourite place.

- Say: Look at Activity 3.
- Explain to the children that they write about their favourite place. Say that they try to use the structures and vocabulary that they have been practising in the unit.
- When they have finished, ask volunteers to read out what their sentences.

LOOK AT ME!

- Draw three overlapping circles (a Venn diagram) on the board and label the circles, water, land, air. Ask: Where can we see (trees), on the land, in the water or in the air?
- Ask children to come to the board and write tree within the correct segment of the circles. Continue with other words: birds, people, boats, clouds, planes, houses, etc.
- The children classify the words in the Venn diagram.
