## INDEX OF PERSONS AND PLACES

Persons are entered under surnames, wives being entered under the surnames of their husbands, and sons and daughters under those of their fathers. The place of origin of a family is treated as a surname, thus, John de Ferlington is entered as 'Ferlington, John de,' and not as 'John, of Ferlington.'

Particulars of relationship, such as 'wife of Simon', or 'son of Adam,' are added where possible. Occupations are only given in the case of men holding local office, ecclesiastics, or where it is necessary for purposes of identification. The place of abode is added where possible.

Place-names are entered under their modern forms, with cross-references, where necessary, from the form in the text. All places are in Yorkshire unless otherwise stated. The name of the wapentake is given in round brackets, after each place-name in the East and North Riding.

The index does not include place-names in marginals.
