MAP OF LONDON, showing the Wards and Liberties as described by Stow, circa 1600. By EMERY WALKER.

Based on a comparison of Stow's text with the maps of Hoefnagel in Braun and Hogenberg's atlas (circa 1560), of Faithorne (1658), and of Morden and Lea (1682). The information so obtained has been laid down on the first edition of the 25inch Ordnance Map of the Survey of 1873. The plan of the Tower is taken from a drawing made in 1597, and engraved in Vetusta Monumenta. The famous map of Ralph Agas was probably based on Hoefnagel's map . . to fold out at end of Vol. II
