

Omar, Pelo and Tefo were visiting Grandpa.

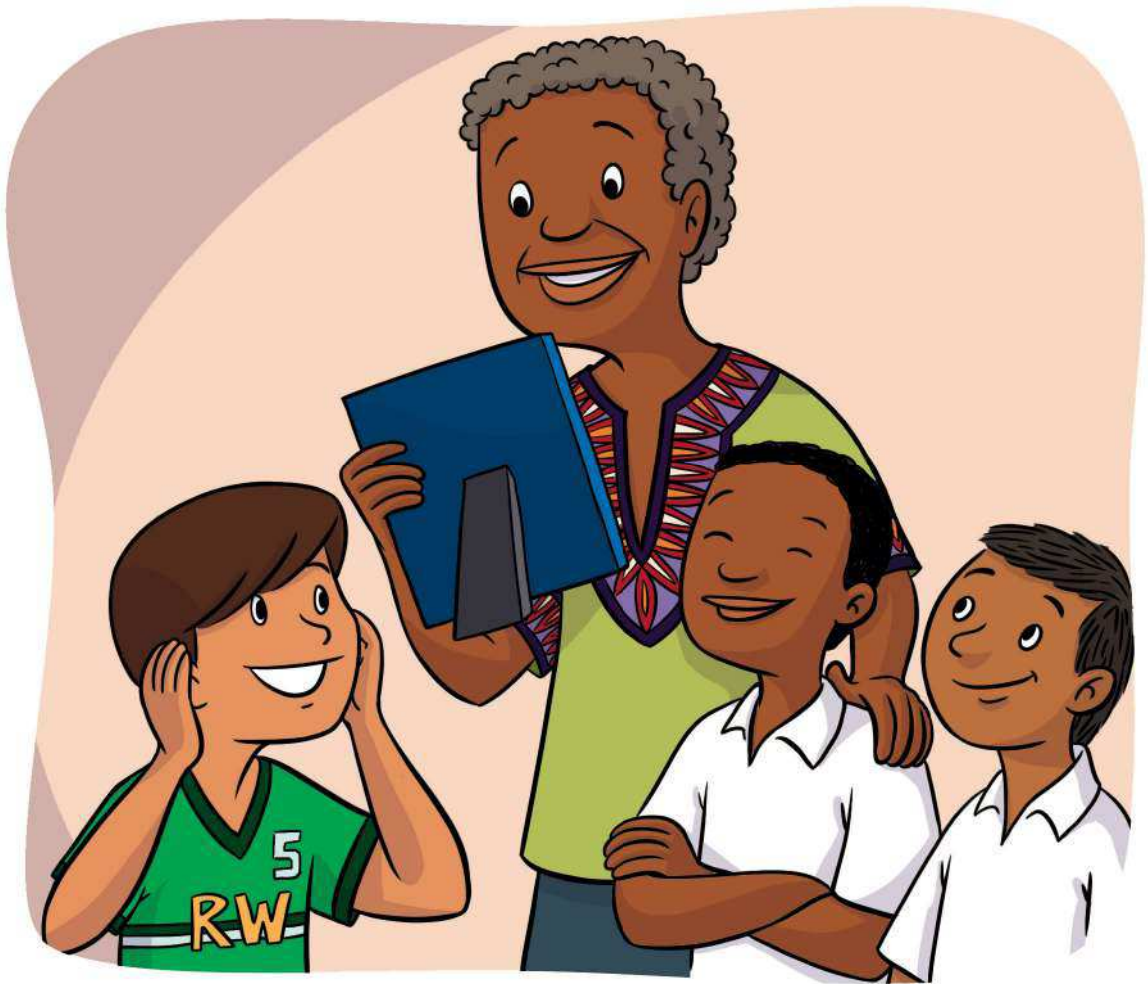
'Is that Pelé?' Omar asked, pointing at a photo on the shelf.
