Mark earned his PhD in musicology from UC Santa Cruz in 2015. His dissertation, "Recording the Nation: Folk Music and the Government in Roosevelt's New Deal, 1936–1941" focused on government-sponsored folk music collecting during the Great Depression. Mark earned his MSIS in information studies at UT Austin in 2014, with a focus on



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academic librarianship, music archiving, and audio preservation. He has worked for the *Journal of the Society for American Music* since 2008, and is currently the journal's editorial associate.

KEVIN DETTMAR is W.M. Keck Professor of English and Director of the Humanities Studio at Pomona College. He is the editor of *The Cambridge Companion to Bob Dylan*; his cultural criticism has appeared in the *New Yorker, Atlantic, New York Times, Los Angeles Times, Chronicle of Higher Education*, and other publications.

FLORENCE DORE is Professor of American literature at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill and a founding member of the board at the TU Institute for Bob Dylan Studies. She has written on the blues, censorship, and literary formalism, and her book *Novel Sounds: Southern Fiction in the Age of Rock and Roll* was published by Columbia University Press in 2018. Florence is also a rock musician finishing her second album. Her first release, *Perfect City* was signed to Slewfoot Records in 2001, and her song "Christmas" was recorded by the Posies for the 1994 Geffen release *Just Say Noel*.

LEIGH H. EDWARDS is Professor of English at Florida State University. She is the author of *Dolly Parton, Gender, and Country Music* (2018), *Johnny Cash and the Paradox of American Identity* (2009), and *The Triumph of Reality TV: The Revolution in American Television* (2013). She focuses on intersections of gender and race in popular music, television, and new media. Her work has appeared in *Feminist Media Studies, The Journal of Popular Culture, Journal of Popular Television, Film & History, Narrative, FLOW*, and the *Journal of Popular Music Studies*. She is on the advisory board of the Institute for Bob Dylan Studies.

James F. English is the John Welsh Centennial Professor of English at the University of Pennsylvania, where he is also founding faculty director of the Price Lab for Digital Humanities. He has published books on modernist and contemporary British literature, the history and future of the discipline of literary studies, and the sociology of literary and cultural value. *The Economy of Prestige*, a study of cultural prizes and awards, was named Best Academic Book of 2005 by *New York* magazine. Current projects include a history of rating and ranking systems in literature and the arts, and a volume of essays on literature and human flourishing, co-edited with Heather Love.

He is co-author, with Ronald D. Cohen, of *Singing for Peace: Antiwar Songs in American History* (2015).

MICHAEL J. KRAMER is an Assistant Professor in the Department of History at SUNY Brockport. He is the author of *The Republic of Rock: Music and Citizenship in the Sixties Counterculture* (2013) and is at work on a book, *This Machine Kills Fascists*, about technology and tradition in the US folk music movement as well as a digital public history project about the Berkeley Folk Music Festival and folk music on the West Coast (bfmf. net). ANDREW MCCARRON is a teacher and writer born and raised in the Hudson River Valley. He holds a PhD in psychology and chairs the Religion, Philosophy & Ethics Department at Trinity School in Manhattan. His books include *Mysterium*, a poetry collection (2011), *Three New York Poets: Charles North, Tony Towle & Paul Violi*, a collection of critical biographies (2016), *Light Come Shining: The Transformations of Bob Dylan*, a study of the Nobel Laureate's religious



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identities (2017), and *The Ballad of Sara and Thor: A Novella* (2017). In addition to teaching and writing, Andrew also serves on the ethics committee at New York Presbyterian Hospital in Manhattan.

ANNE-MARIE MAI is Professor of Literature at University of Southern Denmark, a member of the Danish Academy, and the winner of the Søren Gyldendal Literature Prize. Her research areas include literary historiography, literary archives, the history of Nordic literature, the European and American Beat generation, Bob Dylan studies, and narrative medicine. She is the author of *Bob Dylan*. *The Poet* (2018) and *Danish Literature of the 20th and Early 21st Century* (2016), and editor of *New Approaches to Bob Dylan* (2020).

GREIL MARCUS is the author of *The Old Weird America: The World of Bob Dylan's Basement Tapes* (1997, 2011), *Like a Rolling Stone* (2005, and adapted theatrically by the Comédie Française in 2017), and *Bob Dylan by Greil Marcus* (2010). With Werner Sollors he is the editor of *A New Literary History of America* (2009). He was born in San Francisco and lives in Oakland. His copy of *The Freewheelin' Bob Dylan*, which he bought at the Stanford Shopping Center in 1963, has the wrong songs on it.

ANDREW MUIR is a freelance writer and teacher of English Literature and Language. Current commitments include teaching at the Leys School, Cambridge, UK and delivering a variety of Shakespeare talks at conferences and conventions and on literature and drama courses. His publications include two books on Bob Dylan as a live performer, *Razor's Edge* (2001) and *One More Night* (21013), plus a study of Dylan's lyrics, *Troubadour* (2003), and an examination of historical and contemporary outdoor Shakespeare performances, *Shakespeare in Cambridge* (2015). His latest book came out in 2019 and was entitled *Bob Dylan and William Shakespeare: The True Performing of It.*

KEITH NEGUS is Professor of Musicology at Goldsmiths, University of London. He entered higher education after a few years playing keyboards and guitar in a range of bands. He completed a PhD study of the music industry, and taught at the universities of Leicester and Puerto Rico before joining Goldsmiths. He is the author of *Producing Pop* (1992), *Music Genres and Corporate Cultures* (1999), and *Bob Dylan* (2008) and was a member of the team that researched and wrote the influential *Doing Cultural Studies: The Story of the Sony Walkman* (1997). He collaborated with Pete Astor (The Loft, Weather Prophets) in writing and producing "Love Repeats"/ "Alpha November" (2015) as the Fairlight Myth.

LISA O'NEILL-SANDERS is Professor and Chair of Philosophy at Saint Peter's University where she regularly teaches a course on Bob Dylan and philosophy. She has published numerous articles on Dylan and lectures publicly on the philosophical intersections in Dylan's art. She is the founding editor of the *Dylan Review* (www.dylanreview.org), a scholarly journal devoted to investigating the works of Bob Dylan.

ANN POWERS is NPR Music's critic and correspondent. Her books include *Good Booty: Love and Sex, Black and White, Body and Soul in American Music* (2017), *Weird Like Us: My Bohemian America* (2000), and (with the artist) Tori Amos: *Piece by Piece* (2005). She is the co-editor, with Evelyn McDonnell, of *Rock She Wrote: Women Write about Rock, Rap, and Pop* (1995), the first published anthology of women music writers. In 2017 she founded Turning the Tables, an ongoing NPR initiative re-centering the popular music canon on marginalized, underestimated, and forgotten voices. She lives in Nashville with her family.

DEVON POWERS is Associate Professor of Advertising at Temple University. She is the author of On Trend: The Business of Forecasting the Future (2019), Writing the Record: The Village Voice and the Birth of Rock Criticism (2013), and co-editor of Blowing Up the Brand: Critical Perspectives on Promotional Culture (2010). Her research explores historical and contemporary consumer culture and the dynamics of cultural intermediation, circulation, and promotion. Her work has appeared in Journal of Consumer Culture, New Media & Society, and Critical Studies in Media and Communication, among other publications.

KIM RUEHL is a writer, editor, and folk music advocate based in Asheville, North Carolina. She was an editor of *No Depression* — the roots music journal — for nearly a decade, bringing it back to print in 2015 and ending her run there as editor-in-chief. Her writing about American folk and roots music has also been published by NPR Music, *Billboard*, and *Seattle Weekly*, and she is the author of *A Singing Army: Zilphia Horton and the Highlander Folk School* (2021).

DAVID R. SHUMWAY is Professor of English, and Literary and Cultural Studies, and is the founding Director of the Humanities Center at Carnegie Mellon University. He is also founder and co-director of the Pittsburgh Humanities Festival. His most recent book is *Rock Star: The Making of Musical Icons from Elvis to Springsteen* (2014). He has published numerous articles on popular music, including contributions to *The Cambridge Companion to Bob Dylan* and *The Cambridge Companion to the Singer-*
