



Nouns are naming words. They are names of people, animals, places and things.





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Let us read

Read the passage aloud. Pay attention to the italicised and underlined words.




This is my friend, Supriya.

Her birthday is in September.

She is not from my *city*. She lives in <u>Chennai</u> with her *family*. Her *brother* is called <u>Arun</u>. <u>Suranjan</u> is her *father*. He is a *doctor*.

Nilanjana is her mother. She is a teacher.

Their *dog* is called <u>Rex</u>. They also have a *cat* called <u>Fluffy</u>.



The italicised words are the names of people, animals, places and things of the same kind. Nouns that are general names are called **common nouns**.

Examples: • The *boys* are playing.

- That is a cat.
- The Sun is shining in the sky.

The underlined words are the names of particular people, days, months and places. Nouns that are specific names are called **proper nouns**. They always begin with a capital letter.

Examples: • I am Purvi.

- I was born in July.
- I live in Delhi.

Some proper nouns can be made up of two or more words.

Examples: • Rabindranath Tagore

- Taj Mahal
- Mount Everest
- Himachal Pradesh




