





Il *present simple* è spesso preceduto da avverbi di frequenza come *always*, *sometimes*, *usually*, *often*, *never*.

Si usa il *present continuous* per parlare di azioni che si stanno svolgendo nel momento in cui si parla. Il *present continuous* è spesso accompagnato da espressioni come *now*, *at the moment* ecc.

I **usually watch** musicals, but **now** I'm watching an action film.

Peter **sometimes does** his homework in his room. **Tonight** he's **doing** his homework in the kitchen.



YOUNG ANIMATOR

BUILDING HIS CAREER!

Morgan Spence, 18, is a 'stop-motion animator' from Scotland in the UK. He makes short animation films. But not in the usual way. Morgan uses small toy bricks. He loves building. He builds all the people, buildings and animals. He puts everything together in different ways to make a film set. Morgan doesn't work in a big film studio, but instead he makes his own films in his bedroom at home. He makes films for his school projects and now it is becoming his career!

So how does he do it? Well, first, Morgan builds the film set with toy bricks and adds the people. The people are the **characters** in the film. He works slowly and very carefully. He uses his digital camera to take a photo of the **scene**. Every time he moves a character, adds a brick or changes something in the scene, he takes another photo. And he needs to take a lot of photos to make a film! For every second of film, he takes 15 photos. It takes Morgan about two weeks to make one minute of film.


