How and why do people make political decisions? This book is the first to present a unified framework of the Behavioral Political Science paradigm. BPS presents a range of psychological approaches to understanding political decision-making. The integration of these approaches with Rational Choice Theory provides students with a comprehensible paradigm for understanding current political events around the world.
