#### **ONotes MRCP Part 1**

QNotes MRCP Part 1 has been designed as a companion volume to the Royal College of Physicians MRCP (UK) Part 1 Papers 1997/98 CD-ROM.

QNotes is based on the QBase Interactive MCQ Examinations program and retains all of its functions. Before installing QNotes you must install the QBase MRCP Part 1 Papers 1997/98 CD-ROM onto your computer. Q Notes MRCP Part 1 should only be used with the QBase MRCP Part 1 Papers CD in the CD-ROM drive of your computer. QNotes runs from your hard disk, reads the exam papers and questions from the Part 1 Papers CD-ROM and attaches comprehensive notes to each question.

#### Installation Instructions

Before using QNotes MRCP Part 1 you must install the Royal College Physicians MRCP Part 1 Papers 1997/98 onto your computer

Put the MRCP Part 1 Papers CD in the CD drive of your computer and double click the setup.exe to run the QBase installer.

Remove the MRCP Part 1 Papers CD and insert the QNotes MRCP Part 1 CD into the CD drive.

View the contents of the QNotes CD-ROM.

Copy the folder labelled QNotes MRCP Part 1 onto your desktop (do not change the names of any of the files or folders within this folder).

Remove the QNotes CD from the CD drive and replace it with the MRCP Part 1 Papers CD.

You can now run QNotes from your hard disk by double clicking the QNotes program file.

Q Notes will enhance the value of the questions contained on the Part 1 Papers CD by seamlessly attaching comprehensive notes to them.

See Readme.txt in the ONotes MRCP Part 1 folder for further information.

The Royal College of Physicians is removing negative marking from May 2002, but the format of the MRCP Part 1 examination will remain the same. A non-negatively marked version of *QNotes* will be available shortly on www.greenwich-medical.co.uk/gnotes.

QNotes has been designed to add comprehensive and updateable notes to QBase publications. QNotes has been developed as an extension to the QBase Interactive MCQ Examinations program designed to facilitate revision for postgraduate medical exams. QBase was used by the Royal College of Physicians to release its Part 1 Papers in 2000 on CD-ROM.

QNotes MRCP Part 1 has been designed specifically as a companion volume to the Royal College of Physicians MRCP Part 1 Papers Book/CD. QNotes MRCP Part 1 seamlessly integrates comprehensive notes and explanations with the questions contained on the MRCP Part 1 Papers CD. In order for QNotes MRCP Part 1 to work you must have the Royal College of Physicians MRCP Part 1 Papers 97/98 CD in your CD drive.

The QNotes program will run from your hard disk. QNotes contains all the same functions as QBase. Previous users of QBase will be familiar with the ability to choose predefined exams, set their own mock exams or select questions from a choice of subjects. QNotes will integrate the appropriate notes and explanations with all the questions on the MRCP Part 1 Papers CD and enhance your learning experience. If you have not used QBase before please refer to the Helpfile contained on either the Part 1 Papers or the QNotes CD or press the appropriate button on the quick start menu.

The QNotes/QBase series of books and CDs have been designed to facilitate your revision and learning experience. Unlike traditional book publications the Interactive MCQ Program gives candidates the option and flexibility to make up their own exam papers for revision or assessment. Questions can be selected from the entire pool based on the user's choice of subject and format rather than the fixed order of traditional book publishing. #### **Preface**

This book has been written with the sole aim of annotating the questions, published by Greenwich Medical Media, of the Royal College of Physicians (UK) exam, Membership of the Royal College Part I (MRCP I), for the years 1997 and 1998. In addition to detailed notes on any given topic, each question is referenced, directing the reader to up to date reviews or papers on the subject should they wish to research the area further. In addition to the book a CD-ROM is provided which, once installed to the hard drive on your computer, complements the CD-ROM provided in the College Questions published by Greenwich Medical Media last year (you will still need the original College CD-ROM containing the college questions).

Recently the exam format of the MRCP I has altered and whilst the current QBase program still has the facility to help candidates examine and improve their technique in guessing, by far the greatest advantage of the program is to allow the candidate to do an exam paper 'on screen', choose the format of the exam, store the paper for later use, and finally to identify from the answers areas of weakness that require attention.

#### Medicine and the Internet

One of the themes put forward in QBase Medicine II was the use of computers in medicine. In this preface the theme is developed further with the use of the internet as a resource for studying for the exam. There is no doubt that doing lots of multiple choice questions with focussed answers is the best preparation for the exam however very occasionally further information is required. In addition to textbooks and journals in the library the internet, if used wisely, can be a valuable resource. For those who are complete novices to the subject we have put together a document which serves as an introduction to gaining access to a variety of medical web sites on the internet (Appendix: Membership and the web). This text is also provided on the CD-ROM as a Microsoft Word file and also as a rich text file for those with other word processing applications: if it is installed onto a computer equipped for the internet, then by simply clicking on the 'hyperlink' text you will be taken to the web site in question.
