


Felipe IV liked to go walking in what is now the Parque del Retiro in Madrid. In 1630, as a special present for the king, Felipe’s valido, the Conde-Duque de Olivares, decided to build the Palacio del Buen Retiro.

It took seven years to build. It had more than twenty buildings and two large courtyards. The palace was surrounded by gardens and small lakes.

When the Real Alcázar de Madrid was destroyed by a fire in in 1734, the court moved to the Palacio del Buen Retiro until the construction of the new Palacio Real was completed, in 1763. The Parque del Retiro today marks the grounds of the palace, but the only original building which can still be seen is the Salón de Baile, now known as the Casón del Buen Retiro.


